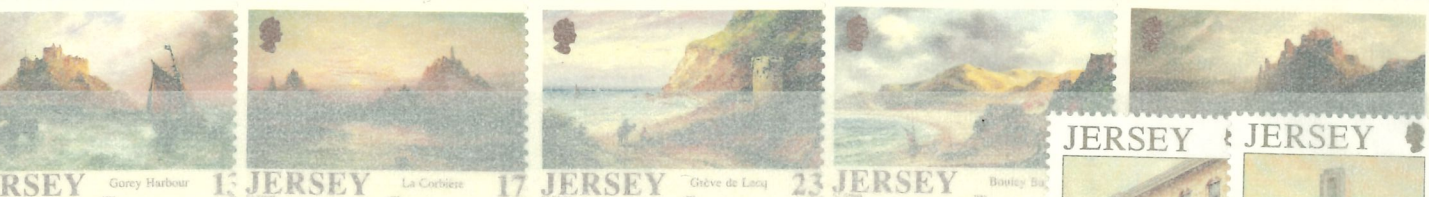


D'Auvergne meets Louis XVI, 1786

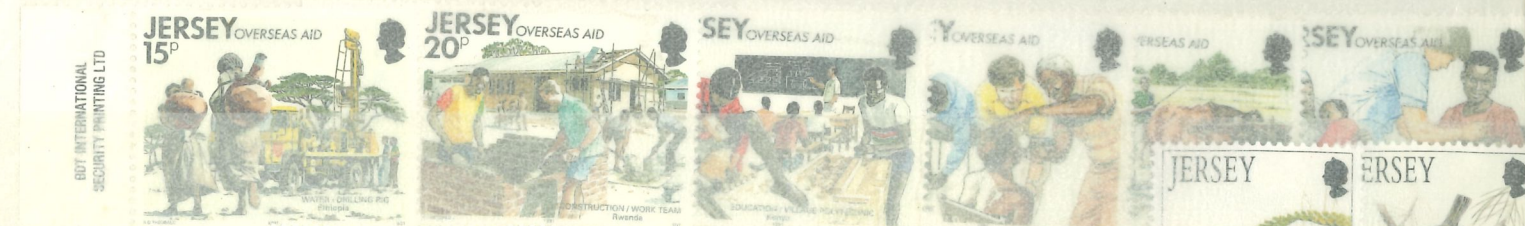
In 1786, escorting the son of the English Home Secretary on the «Grand Tour», Jersey's Captain Philippe D'Auvergne, Royal Navy, at 32 a veteran of Arctic exploration, the Revolutionary War in America and the campaign against the French in India, twice ship-wrecked and once captured, Doctor of Laws and Fellow of the Royal Society, the protégé of Godefroy de la Tour d'Auvergne, Comte d'Evreux, Duc de Bouillon, is presented to Louis XVI at Fontainebleau by the ageing Duke as his adoptive son. With France and Britain officially at peace since the Treaty of Versailles in January, 1783, D'Auvergne divides his time between England, Jersey

Mission from Mont Orgueil, 1795

By 1795, much has happened to the Revolution, and Captain Philippe D'Auvergne. Not having adopted him as promised, when pressed in 1791 to settle the Bouillon succession the Duke nevertheless nominated Philippe, the Assembly appointed him Prince-Successor and in February 1792 King George III of England gave him permission to accept. In July however, with Louis XVI's acceptance of the National Assembly's new Constitution, a worried Europe opposed the Revolution, the Jacobins rallied France and imprisoned the King, and with his execution in January, 1793 France was again at war with England. D'Auvergne, appointed commander of a British Naval Squadron to protect Jersey against invasion, attack French shipping, and gather intelligence, moves his Headquarters to the castle of Mont Orgueil, on the island's east coast.

The two Bailiwicks have much in common, not least being a reliance on air and sea transport for the conveyance of mail.

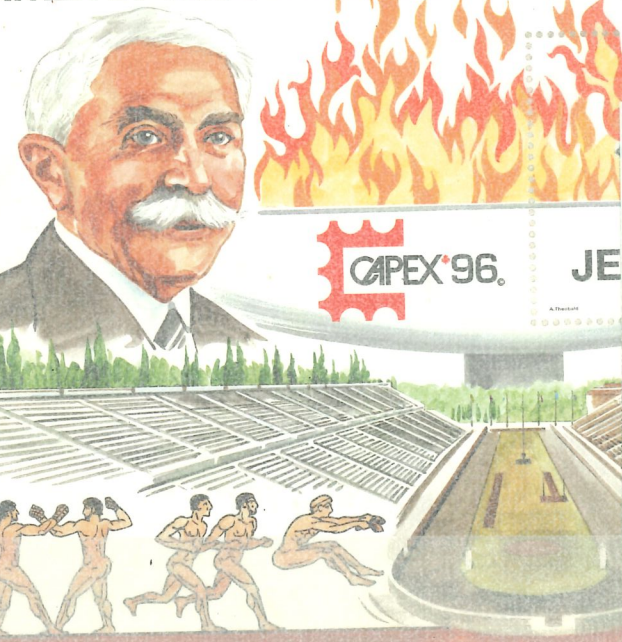

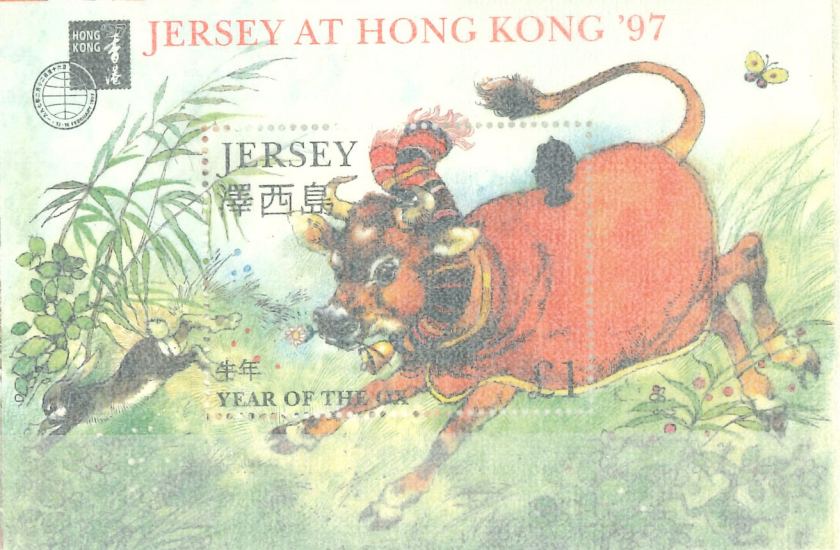

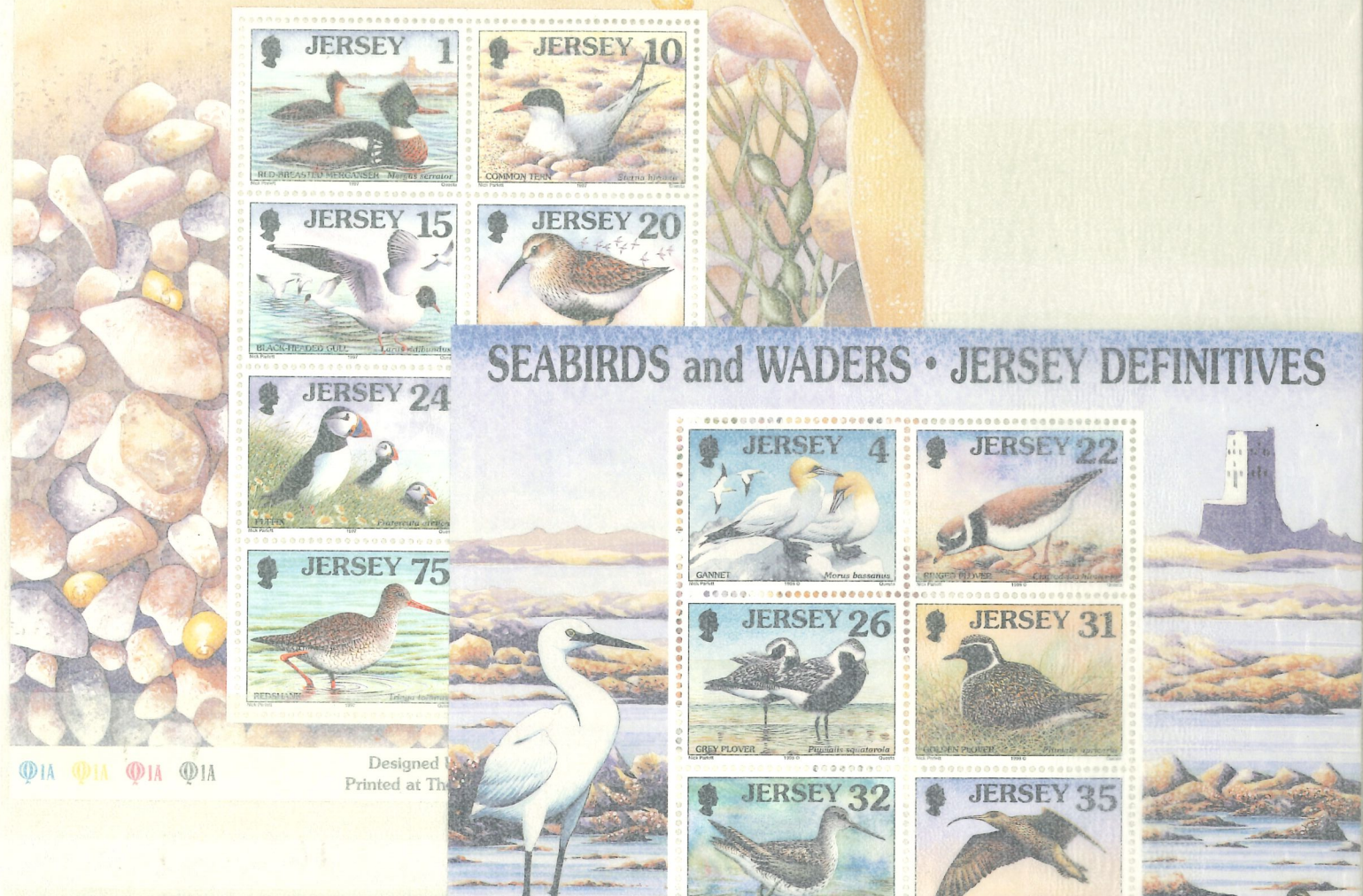
