



He adds a postage stamp for the reply and this is noted on the letter by the Vaguemestre who is in charge of the postal services at the prison.

This letter was addressed to an

officer under training on board the Messageries Maritimes mailboat *Charente* at Marseille. This was redirected on arrival with m/s Suez in blue. From there it was forwarded again in turn to Colombo, Singapore and Saigon-Central before being returned to France on M/M *Indus* on 12.10, arriving back at Marseille on 8.11. It then took three efforts to locate the addressee at Lambezellic, Brest and finally La Roche-s-Yonne.





The returned and dead letter office "Rebuts" was a central service based either at Paris Recette Principale for Paris and other mail or at certain large towns. This cachet was, in all likelihood, applied at Le Mans.

Only post office officials at the Rebuts were authorised to open letters in order to obtain the return address of the sender. It was necessary for the mail to be marked with some form of stamp justifying the opening of the letter which, in principle but not in these circumstances, amounted to a breach in the law of privacy.






